Recitals:

WHEREAS, the parties were lawfully married and have since separated; and WHEREAS, the parties desire to settle and resolve all property rights, obligations, and interests arising from their marriage in a fair and equitable manner without litigation.

Section 1 – Separate Property:

Each party shall retain sole ownership, control, and enjoyment of all property, assets, and debts that were owned prior to the marriage, inherited individually, or acquired by gift specifically designated to one party.

Section 2 – Marital Property:

All property, assets, and debts acquired by either party during the marriage, except for separate property, shall be considered marital property and subject to equitable division between the parties as follows:

Section 3 – Debts and Liabilities:

The parties agree that all marital debts and liabilities not separately listed shall be divided equitably. Each party is responsible for debts listed under their name and shall indemnify the other party against such debts.

Section 4 – Real Property:

Section 5 – Retirement Accounts and Investments:

The parties agree to divide retirement accounts, pensions, and investment accounts in accordance with applicable laws, including the preparation and execution of Qualified Domestic Relations Orders (QDROs) where necessary.

Personal property, household goods, vehicles, and other tangible items shall be divided as follows:

Section 9 – Legal Fees and Costs:

Each party shall be responsible for their own legal fees and costs incurred in connection with the negotiation and execution of this Agreement, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Section 10 – Entire Agreement and Amendments:

This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter herein and supersedes

all prior negotiations and agreements. Any amendments or modifications must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Section 11 – Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____. The parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the state and federal courts located in _____ County, _____.
